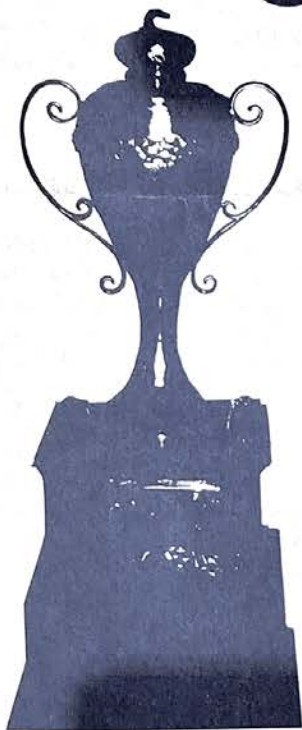

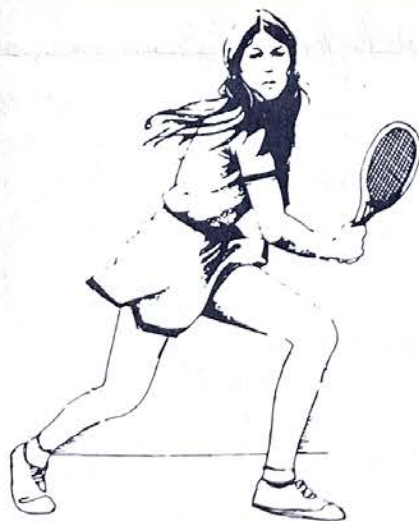

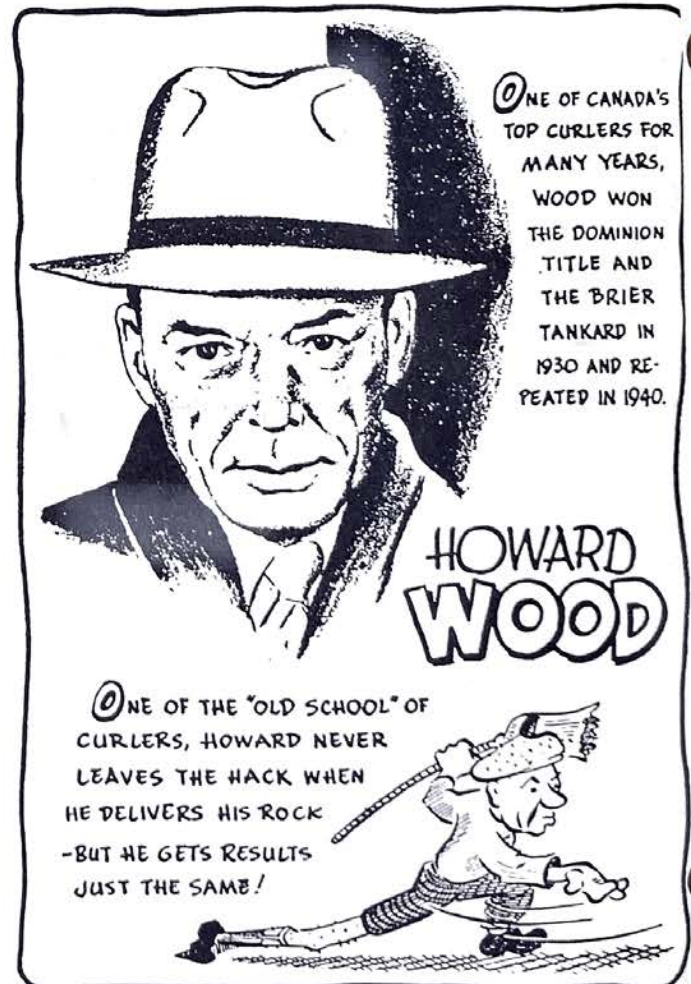

The debenture will be issued in \$500.00 multiples maturing in 10 years (December 31, 1996). The rate will be 10% paid yearly with 10% of the principal paid yearly.
