#### From the Ice Maker Blading

Blading is part of our regular Ice Maintenance and is done daily Monday through Friday on all twelve sheets. The purpose behind blading is to help prevent excess pebble build-up, especially on the outside areas of the sheet; this keeps the entire sheet more consistent and a little cleaner as well. By removing the pebble you also remove some of the surface dirt so it aids in keeping the ice clean.

Blading is done with a 21 inch blade pushed up one side of the sheet then down the other, moving inward after each pass until the entire sheet has been completed. This takes ten passes on each sheet. The ice is then swept to remove the snow, pebbled, and it is ready for play.

I would like to wish everyone good luck in the upcoming Bonspiels.
