From the Ice Maker

It is the policy of this Club to have curling members involved in keeping the ice clean. The practice of having either the winners (as it is this year) or losers sweep the ice after their game reduces maintenance time between draws without sacrificing ice quality. A thorough job of cleaning the ice involves:

1. Sweeping the ice surface under the rocks.
2. Sweeping the debris from in the hacks and behind them to an area in front of them where the mop has easy access.
3. Sweeping along the side dividers.
4. Pushing the mop up and down the ice, finishing off to the side or in the corner.
5. Removing the debris from the mop and the ice surface with the broom and dust pan.

The ice crew cleans and prepares the ice every morning by hand blading, washing out the hacks and applying fresh pebble. For the rest of the day, it is up to you, the curler, to clean the ice after every time you use it; whether it be an important league game or just an hour of practice.

Ice Booking Procedure

We would ask that when booking ice for rentals, bonspiels and make-up games that it is done through Vera in the Curling Office. The Curling Office is open from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

If you wish to book ice when the Curling Office is not open on weekends, you may do so by contacting Flo McKinley, our Food and Beverage Manager. Other personnel can indicate that a sheet of ice is open but they cannot book the ice. If curlers want to be guaranteed a sheet of ice they must book through Vera or Flo.

Curlers, we would ask that when you are practicing you consult the Draw Sheet posted on the Bulletin Board. Please ensure that you leave the sheet 10 minutes prior to the scheduled draw time. This will enable ice personnel to prepare the ice for the scheduled draw.

Your co-operation in this regard is greatly appreciated and will help ensure that regularly scheduled games get started on time.

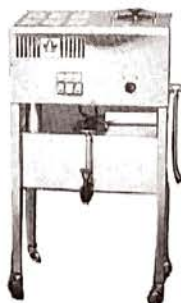

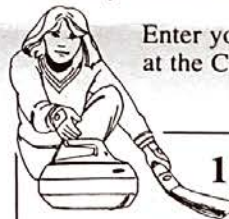
