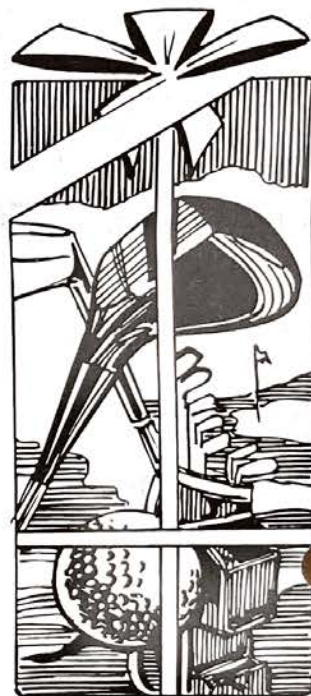

Club Captain's Report

As you read these comments we are hopefully only 1 to 2 weeks away from playing our course. There are a few items I would like to bring to everyone's attention prior to the start of the season.

a) Please review the Tournament schedule in this edition of the Georgian. Previous printings contained some errors around the dates of Club Championship play in June. Some members have approached me with some concerns around the Pepsi Scramble being scheduled on the May long weekend. This was done to reduce the number of tournaments being held on weekends in July and August, our prime summer golfing months. We realize that the course is not in top notch shape in May, but if you look at the Schedule of Tournaments there weren't any other weekends considering it is a 2 day tournament and remember you get 4 chances to make the right shot even if conditions aren't perfect.

b) For those members who like to carry cell phones, I would encourage you to leave the phones in your car so you can enjoy your game, but more importantly it is appropriate consideration for those golfing with you. Nothing can be more annoying than a cell phone ringing as you prepare to swing or you are concen-

trating on a putt. Please remember, we all survived and businesses survived for four hours before the invention of cell phones and fax machines.

c) Last year the average time for a round of golf improved somewhat and I want to compliment everyone for making an effort to reduce our time on the course. Let's all strive to continue this by working towards no more than 4 hrs 10 min. in 1997. Remember, most of the time is spent on the greens so if we all are aware that we are not playing in the Canadian Open, or Masters, the game will go along much faster.

d) The Prince George Golf & Country Club is part of Zone 8 along with Quesnel, Williams Lake, Valemount and Mackenzie. The Zone has recently established a bursary Fund for Junior Golf. Once a year a successful recipient will receive a \$500.00 bursary to assist someone who is embarking on a career in the Golf industry. i.e. Turf Management, Club Management, Course Supervision etc. If any individual or company would like to make a contribution to this fund or receive more information please contact me at 563-4844.
