From the Ice Maker

As most everyone is aware, Shorty Jenkins was here on the weekend of November 22-24 to go over our operation and to have a look at our rocks. Our rocks have been an issue for the last couple of years and after a close inspection, a few things stuck out for both Shorty and me.

First, the rocks are sharp with a running surface of about 3.5mm, with 5.25mm to 5.75mm being optimum. There were also a number of stones that were quite pitted. Twelve of the rocks were out of rotation or had been flipped at some point in time. It is these factors that determine how fast a rock is and how much it curls. You might wonder how we can see all of this just by looking at it since it can be difficult to pick up every detail by eye. We went through a process called blueprinting which takes an imprint of the running surface and shows us everything: the width, the inside diameter of the cup, how many pits there are, where they are and how big they are. We then decided to go ahead and widen the running surface which should both speed up the rocks and remove most or all of the pits. This was all completed in the short time Shorty was here.

Our next step was to re-blueprint every rock on sheets 1-8, record all the data and send it off to Shorty. Shorty then inputs the data into a computer and the computer matches one odd ball set with another. Because there were some mismatched rocks before we did the widening process, there will be some mismatched pairs now. Some of the rocks that were badly pitted or were of harder granite may have to be fine-tuned, but this is a process that can now be done in-house and will be done as soon as possible.






